Always innovative, Liberty constantly strives to make their safes the toughest and most user-friendly possible. Over the years, they have introduced such improvements as its HiSecurity Composite Door, and their patented unique bolt locking mechanism currently used on all composite steel doors. Their 4-in-1 Flex storage system, provides adjustable shelving and shelf covers that allow you to configure the interior four different ways. Demonstrating their desire to meet the needs of customers, Liberty introduced the accessory

door panel. It allows you to store accessories and handguns for easy access as the door is opened. Included is the Cool Pocket, located on the bottom right hand corner of the door, to keep papers safe in a fire.

All safes carry the trusted U.L. Listing for Residential security. This means that they have undergone rigorous testing by U.L. technicians including drilling, hammering, chiseling, punching, prying and tampering. The attacks are directed at the door, body, lock and bolt-locking mechanisms of the safe. In addition, Liberty and National Security safes have undergone extensive fire testing. In 2007, Liberty introduced the BTU fire rating system where each safe has a total BTU value of how much heat it can take. This has

proven to be very valuable for consumers confused by wild claims in the market place. Liberty certifies each safe by using leading testing technology and standards as established by ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials).

Liberty offers 25 different safe models within 6 series, including two-dozen colors to match any home décor. The latest offerings, The Fatboy and Fatboy Jr, are currently Liberty's most popular safes. The massive Fatboy is one of the largest and toughest security vaults built in America and holds an impressive 64 guns. Security features abound, including the all new DX-90 Monster Mech, which includes 25% larger and 33% longer bolts, anti pry-tabs and a new over-center cam mechanism to discourage punching. Backed by 83,000 BTU fire protection, the

Fatboy now has more fireboard than ever, including 60 minutes @ 1200°F. Liberty's 4-in-1 Flex interior with double collector rack provides the ultimate in storage flexibility.

Next in line is the value priced Fatboy Jr wide body safe that holds 48 guns. It offers features normally not found in its price range, including UL listed locks, multiple locking bolts and composite door and relocking devices to deter forced entry. Fire protection is upgraded with 80,000 BTUs (extra layer in the ceiling and door).
